### **Available for Faculty, Online E-Reserve Form**

It's here! The online library reserve form, conveniently located and easy to use, is ready to go! To access the Reserve Request Form from the Library's home page:

Go to lib.mnsu.edu

Select "Course Reserves."

Select "FOR PROFESSORS: Reserve Request Form Online."

After completing the online form, faculty have three submission options. The form can be sent to the Library electronically, it can be printed out and sent through intra-campus mail, or it can be printed and delivered to the Library along with the material to be placed on reserve.

#### **Library Reserve Procedures**

- **Electronic reserve for journal articles or book chapters:** Provide a pdf of the material or a photocopy to be scanned.
- Hard-copy reserve for library-owned books, videos, and DVDs: Record the call number on the Online Reserve Request form. Library staff will pull the material from the Library shelves and process it for the
- Hard-copy reserve for a personal copy of a book, video or DVD: Deliver the material to the Library or send it through campus mail. Be aware that the Library will place clear tape on all hard-copy reserves.

Due to the large number of requests received at the beginning of each semester, it may take up to five working days to process reserve submissions. Please submit your requests five working days prior to the date needed.

#### Reserving ERC Videos for Class Viewing

Are you planning on using Minnesota State University, Mankato Library films in your classroom? To guarantee the availability of Library videos for the dates you need them, be sure to contact the ERC staff at 507-389-5944 as soon as you've scheduled the showing, with the following information:

- The titles you need.
- The dates you want to show the films.

Unless reserved by ERC staff, videos circulate to all qualified borrowers, including interlibrary loan requests. The sooner you let the ERC staff know what you need, the better they will be able to ensure the films' availability for your class.

NOTE: Library and personal videos can also be put on Reserve for in-Library viewing.

#### New Version of SciFinder Scholar

SciFinder Scholar is all about chemistry. It provides citations and abstracts for patents and journal articles as well as information about chemical substances, regulated chemicals, chemical reactions, and chemical supplier information. Nearly 22.4 million citations from over 9,000 journals worldwide are included.

- Use **Internet Explorer** to download the software.
- If you are downloading the software from off campus, you will be required to authenticate using your May username and password.
- Off campus, SciFinder Scholar can only be used with the full virtual private network (VPN) running.
