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Method

Procedure

CETL distributed an electronic version of the survey to the entire student body on September 16th. Surveys remained open for a two-week period, asking students to submit their responses by September 25th.

The survey included an email invitation to complete the survey. Students who wanted to complete the survey simply clicked on a link embedded in the invitation. The link directed them to the survey.

When they opened the survey, participants were informed that

- The survey was being used to gather information on their learning experiences and feedback on improvements
- o Responses would be anonymous.
- The survey may be redistributed multiple times throughout the semester to trach changes over the semester.








Q3: Which choice describes your student status at Minnesota State, Mankato?


Q4: Which Minnesota State, Mankato college does your major fall into?




Q13A: How frequently did your instructors use D2L for <u>communication</u>?


Q13B: How frequently did your instructors use D2L for grades?


Q13C: How frequently did your instructors use D2L for <u>assignment submissions</u>?


Q13D: How frequently did your instructors use D2L for <u>sharing content</u>?


Q14: How would you rate your instructors' presence during the Fall 2020 semester?


Q15: How would you rate your instructors' accessibility during the Fall 2020 semester?






Q20B: Indicate your comfort level with the following tools used in online teaching and courses. - Zoom






