In 1997 there were no established mountain bike trails in the Hot Springs, SD area. JR Lavielle and Josh Hodorff were forced to find their own riding trails. They quickly found that the Black Hills were full of old logging roads that were no longer being used. These roads proved to be some of the best trails they had ever ridden.

After discovering these roads, they were approached with the idea to promote them as mountain bike trails so that others could enjoy them.

JR and Josh felt the best way to make people aware of the trails' existence was to give them maps of the trails. This soon led to the idea of making tourism brochures for the Chamber of Commerce and other locations.

The idea became reality when they received funding from a Rural Economic Development Grant. Using GPS computer technology they rode the trails and made precise maps of the trails. Working with the US Forest Service, they proceeded to edit the maps into a brochure.
